DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The project generally consists of supplying liquid asphalt to Okanogan County Department of Public Works for 2021 Season.

3. Bids received by the County may not be withdrawn after the time set in the notice for bid opening. All bids received shall be opened at the time and place set in the notice inviting bids. The bid award will be made within thirty (30) days of the date of the opening of bids, unless complicating circumstances arise.
4. The Board of Commissioners of Okanogan County, reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive informalities in bidding.
5. Bids must be submitted on the “Bid Submittal Form”, which is available from the office of Okanogan County Department of Public Works, 1234-A 2nd Avenue South, Okanogan, Washington 98840.
6. All prices shown in the Bid shall be delivered prices to the various locations as seen in Google Earth link.
7. All materials supplied under this proposal shall conform to Section 9-02 of the 2021 WSDOT Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction including amendments when applicable. Deliveries of asphalt with a loading temperature below the minimum specified may be rejected. No compensation will be given to the material supplier for rejected asphalt and all related shipping costs will be deducted from any monies due to supplier.
