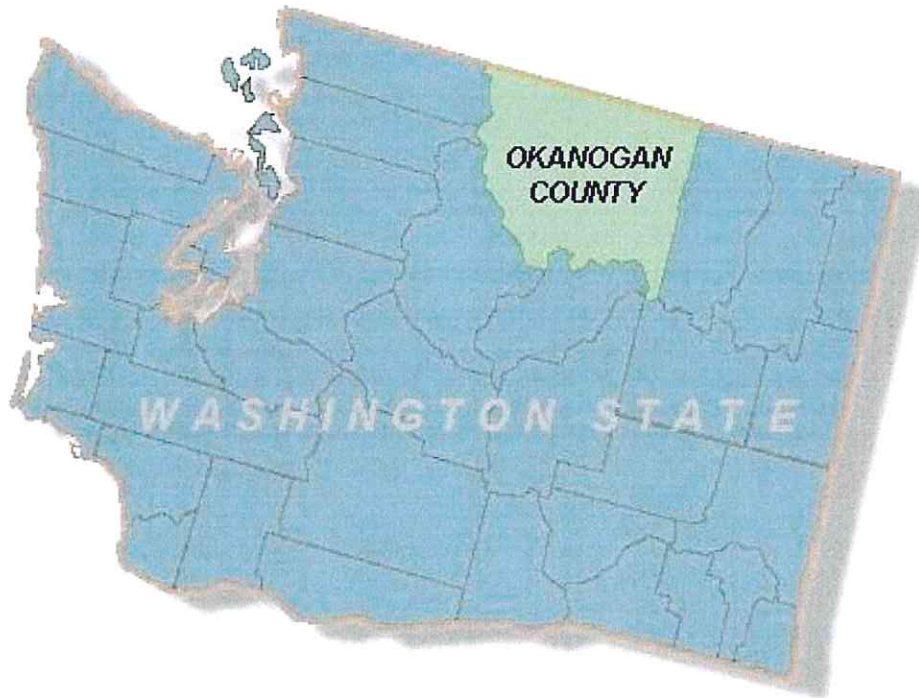

Sealed bids, plainly marked “**BID FOR 2021 – Soil Stabilizer**”, will be received by Okanogan County at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners located in the Grainger Administrative Building, 123 5th Avenue N, Room 150, Okanogan, WA, 98840, until **11:00 A.M., March 2, 2021** at which time they will be opened and publicly read.

The Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County, Washington, reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The award of this contract, if made, will be to the lowest responsible bidder.

The improvement for which bids will be received follows:

2021 – Soil Stabilizer

This contract provides for the placement of **735** Tons of Liquid Magnesium Chloride (30%) on selected county roads in Okanogan County, WA all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions and the Standard Specifications.

BIDDER'S CHECK LIST

MAGNESIUM CHLORIDE (30%)

Description

This work consists of furnishing and placing Magnesium Chloride (30%) on County Roads as shown on the plans.

Materials

Magnesium Chloride (30%) shall meet the following requirements:

Chemical Properties

Magnesium Chloride	29.0 – 32.0
Sulfates	1.50 – 3.50
Potassium	0.10 – 0.50
Water	64.0 – 70.0

Labeled for dust control.

Construction Requirements

All roadway surfacing, grading, watering, compacting and traffic control will be performed by the County and coordinated with the supplier in such a way as to maximize the efficiency and life of the treatment.

The supplier shall have the capability of applying the material to the roadway with a calibrated pressure system on the truck and supply Okanogan County with documents showing the application rate and total quantities of Magnesium Chloride (30%) applied to each individual road.

The application rate varies from 0.25 gal/s.y. to 0.50 gal/s.y. as shown on the plans.

The supplier shall be able to supply up to 105 tons of Magnesium Chloride (30%) per 10 hour work shift to any given job site.

Measurement

Magnesium Chloride (30%) will be measured by the ton.

Payment

"Magnesium Chloride (30%)", per Ton

The unit contract price per ton for "Magnesium Chloride (30%)" shall be full pay to complete the work as specified.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into between the Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County, State of Washington, acting under and by virtue of Title 36 and Title 39 R.C.W. as amended, hereinafter referred to as "The County," and

WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the terms and conditions contained herein and attached and made a part of this Agreement, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Contractor shall do all work and furnish all labor, tools, materials, and equipment necessary to construct and complete the following for Okanogan County, Washington:

2021– Soil Stabilizer

in accordance with attached Bid Submittal Form.

The Contractor shall provide and bear the expense of all materials, labor, equipment, tools, and work of any sort whatsoever that may be required for the transfer of materials and for constructing and completing the work provided for in these contract documents.
